**ABANDONING AN INGROUND OIL TANK**

*A Permit is required in Rockville Centre in order to abandon an inground oil tank.*

**REQUISITES FOR PERMIT**

As a Rockville Centre licensed plumber you will need to submit the following:

- RVC Plumbing Permit - obtained from Building Dept.
- Proper workers' compensation & liability insurance  
(Requirements at Building Dept.)
- Nassau County Department of Health Small Tank Abandonment Form

If you are not a Rockville Centre licensed plumber, you will need to submit the following:

- Completed RVC Building Application form – from Building Department ( indicating size and location of tank)
- Proper workers' compensation and liability insurance (requirements at Building Dept.)
- Affidavit of no plumbing – from Building Dept.
- Affidavit of no electrical – from Building Dept.

**\*Homeowner Small Fuel Oil Tank Removals and Abandonments. (516-227-9691)**

This program regulates the removal or abandonment of fuel oil tanks 1100 gallons or less used for space heating.
