INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF ROCKVILLE CENTRE BUILDING DEPARTMENT <u>DECK PERMITS</u>

All wood decks with a walking surface in excess of 8 inches above unenhanced adjacent grade will require a <u>Building Permit</u>.

REQUISITES FOR BUILDING PERMIT:

- Building Permit application.
- Completed Rockville Centre residential building application entry form. (May be obtained from the Building Department).
- Copy of contractor's current Nassau County Home Improvement license.
- Two (2) copies of an accurate and legible survey of your property.
- Completed Residential Zoning Affidavit.
- Two (2) detailed construction drawings of the work to be done stamped by a NYS licensed engineer or architect.
- If electrical work is to be done, an electrical application must be filed by a RVC licensed electrician and submitted with the application.
- Proper workers' compensation & liability insurance from contractor (requirements at Building Department).
- Check for permit fee based on the current fee schedule.
- Fee for Letter of Completion (based on current fee schedule) which will be issued after a final inspection is performed.
