

APPRENTICE LINE MAINTAINER

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Under direct supervision is taught the techniques of the maintenance and repair of power lines; performs related duties as required.

TYPICAL DUTIES

1. Receives training and assists in stringing cables, and erecting poles.
2. Receives instruction in the use of tools, equipment, safety devices and precautions.
3. Receives training and assists in the installation and maintenance of underground lines.
4. Receives instructions and assists in the installation of electric meters and service wires.
5. Receives instructions and assists in splicing, soldering and pulling cable.
6. Takes tests to demonstrate degree of proficiency acquired.
7. Performs other work as assigned.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

1. Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions.
2. Good physical condition, not subject to acrophobia or claustrophobia.
3. Ability to learn to proficiently climb poles and perform basic line work on secondary lines and services within 5 months under supervision of a qualified line worker.
4. Ability to learn to perform basis line work on secondary lines and services within 5 months from a bucket truck under supervision of a qualified line worker.
5. Also must obtain appropriate driving licenses within 90 days.
6. Ability to learn and understand electric utility systems operations, construction and work methods.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS, TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE

1. Completion of high school.
2. Preference will be given to external candidates with graduation from an electrical trade school and with electrical work experience.
3. Preference will be given to Village employees with the above qualifications as per the CSEA contract.
