Village Elections June 19

Village elections are scheduled for Tuesday, June 19 to elect a mayor, two trustees, and a Village justice. All seats are for four-year terms.

Any Village resident who is registered to vote in Nassau County may vote in the Village election. Unregistered newcomers, those who have changed addresses since last November, and new voters must register with the County Board of Elections by June 8 in order to be eligible to vote in this election.

Residents planning to vote by absentee ballot must file an application at Village Hall no later than June 12 for mail ballots and no later than June 18 for personal applications. Absentee ballots must be received no later than June 19 at 5 P.M.

Yannelli Honored by Nassau Bar

Rockville Centre Village Justice Frank E. Yannelli will be honored

on April 28 as the 64th recipient of the Distinguished Service Medalion awarded by the Nassau County Bar Association for service which has enhanced the reputation and dignity of the legal profession.



Judge Yannelli, a past president of the Nassau County Bar Association and of the Criminal Court's Bar Association, is being

recognized "for his high moral character and integrity, and for his record of distinguished service to the public," according to a statement from the Bar Association.

"There can be no better role model for a person entering this profession than

long-time service on the Character and Fitness Committee.

Judge Yannelli has been a practicing attorney since 1964 and has served as a Village Justice since 1983. He also serves on the boards of the RVC Economic Opportunity Council, the RVC Education Foundation, and Confide, Rockville Centre's drug, alcohol and crisis counseling center.

FY 2008 Budget \$33.3 Million

The Village has announced a tentative budget for fiscal year 2008 of \$33.3 million, an increase of 5.3 percent over last year.

Copies of the tentative budget are available for public inspection at Village Hall and are also on the Village's website at www.rvcny.us/mayor.html. The proposed budget calls for a 5.9

percent increase in the tax rate, adding about \$130 to the average Rockville Centre tax bill. The proposed new tax rate is \$29.95 per \$100 NAV or \$2,336 for a home assessed at \$7,800.

A public hearing on the budget was held March 26. The Board of Trustees must adopt a budget by May 1. The adopted budget will go into effect June 1, 2007.
